Survey made with Burt's Patent Improved Solar
Compass new and in first-rate order. Made by
John Roach of San Francisco Cal
Instrument examined and compared with the true
Meridian at Reno April 20th 1882 and
found correct. At noon on April 23rd 1880
I set my instrument at the Cor. to sec 35+36 T41N Rge.
68 E. I took the latitude and found it to be 41°
22' N. I carefully examined all the adjust-
