N. B., T. 14 N., R. 23 E., Mt. D. M.

Survey made with Burt's Patent Improved Solar
Compass nearly new and in first-rate order. Made by
John Roach of San Francisco Cal
Instrument examined and compared with the true
Meridian at Reno. April 16th 1882 and
found correct. At noon on April 22nd 1882

I set my instrument at the Cor. to Tps. 14 & 15 N. Rgs. 23

& 24 E. I took the latitude and found it to be

39° 06' N. I carefully examined all the adjust-
ments and found them correct.

From the Cor. to Tps. 14 & 15 N. Rs. 23, . & 24 E,
which is a stone 24 x 12 x 8 ins. 15 ins. in the ground
marked with 6 notches on N. S. E & W Edges
and mound of stone

I run West on random line on N. B. of Tp.

Va. 17° East.

I set temporary corners at every half mile, and at 5-
miles 6810 chs. I arrive at a point 29 lks. N of Cor. to
Tps. 14 & 15 N. Rs. 22 & 23 E

Which is a Mint Pine Tree 12" Diam
Marked T. 15 N. S. 31 on N. E. R. 23, S. 6 on S. E
T. 15 N. S. 36 on N. W. R. 22, E. S. 1 on S. W
Pits N. S. E & W. of Tree. and Mound of
Earth around Tree from which cor. I run N. 89° 58' E
on a true line between sections 6. & 31 with same va.

Descend abrupt side of ravine

18. or Bottom of Ravine about 100 ft. deep course S. E and ascend
