ments and found them correct.

From the corner to Townships

1 & 2 N. Rgs 33 & 34 E

which is a stone 20 x 14 x 7 ins. 14 ins. in the ground
marked with 6 notches on N. S. E. & West edges
and mound of stone with pits

I run West on random line on N. B. of Tp. 1 N. R 33
Va. 16 1/2° East.

I set temporary corners at every half mile, and at six
miles or 92 chs. I arrive at a point 134 lks. S. of Cor. to

Tps. 1 & 2 N. R. 32 & 33 E

which is a stone 22 x 10 x 8 ins. 16 ins. in the ground
marked with 6 notches on N. S. E. & W. edges
and mound of stone alongside. Whence bears

A Nut Pine 15 ins. diam., S 47° W. 41 lks. dist.
marked T. 1 N R. 32 E S. 1 B. T.

B Nut Pine 10 ins. diam., S 60° E 34 lks. dist.
marked T. 1 N R. 33 E S. 6 B. T.
