

Chains

From the corner to Sections 35, 36, 1 and 2 on the South boundary, Which is a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, firmly set in the ground, marked T. 18 N. S. 36 on N. E., R. 40 E. S. 1 on S. E. T. 17 N. S. 2 on S. W. and S. 35 on N. W. faces, with 5 notch on W and 1 notch on E edges. and pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. in each sec., 5 1/2 ft. dist., and mound of earth 2 ft. high, 4 1/2 ft. base around post.

Run North on a true line between sections 35, 36 Over nearly level ground Va. 17 1/2° East.

2.00 Cross Road, bears, N 50° E

30.00 Cross Road, bears, N 80° E

34.30 Dry Channel 15 lks. wide, course S 75° W

40.00 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for 1/2 Sec. Cor., marked 1/2 S. on W face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N and S of post 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base, around post.

70.00 Dry Channel 40 lks. wide, course SW

80.00 Set a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Secs. 25, 26, 35 + 36 marked T. 18 N. S. 25 on N. E., -R 40 E, S. 36 on S. E., -S. 35 on S. W. and S. 26 on N. W. face with 1 notch on S. and 1 notch on E. edges. dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins. in each Sec., 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, 4 1/2 ft. base around post.
