47.00 Ravine about 50 feet deep, course S E

54.00 Road to Austin course S 58° E and ascend

80.00 Set a granite stone 18 x 10 x 9 ins. 12 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 28, 29, 32 & 33 marked with 1 notch on S. and 4 notches on E. edges and raised a mound of stone alongside. Whence bears

A Nut Pine 12 ins. diam., S 38° E 16 lks. dist. marked T 19 N R. 41 E S., 33 B. T.
