C.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. face, dug pits  $18 \times 18 \times 12$  ins., N. and S. of stone  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base;

80.00 Set a post  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long, 4 ins square, 12 ins. in the ground, for Standard Cor. to Tps. 20 S., R's 63 and 64 E. marked S. C. T. 20 S., R. 64 E. S. 31, on E. and R. 63 E. S. 36, on N. faces with 6 notches on N. E. & W. faces, dug pits,  $24 \times 18 \times 12$  ins. crosswise on each line, N. E. & W. of post, 6 ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high & st. base, around post.
