Va. 15040' East.

40.50 Set a Sand stone 16 x 7 x 4 ins., 11
ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on W.
face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits
impracticable.

81.55 Intersect the 4th Standard Parallel North at a
point $\frac{25.50}{25.50}$ chs. West. of the Standard Cor. to
Secs. 31 and 36. Tps. 16 S., R. 67 and 68, at which
point I.

Set a Washed stone 16 x 12 x 10 ins., 11 ins. in the
ground, for ^{Closing} Cor. to Tps. 17 S., R's 66 and
67 E., marked C. C. with 6 notches on S, E. & Wedges,
and raised a mound of stone, Pits impracticable,
Land rolling.
