

Survey made with Burt's Patent
Improved Solar Compass, nearly new and
in first rate order. Made by W. and L. E.
Gurley, of Troy N. Y., in 1881.

On the 1st day of September, 1882, I set my
instrument at the Cor. to Sps. 1 and 2 N.,
Rs. 65 and 66 E., and carefully examined
it in all its adjustments,
particularly the latitude and
reversing apparatus and found
them correct.

I took the latitude and found
it to be $37^{\circ} 58'$ North.

I then proceed to survey as
follows:
