Chains.

West. on a true line between sections 6 and 31.

Va. $16^{\circ}30'$ East.

Descend.

17.00 Cross Gulch, 10 lks. wide, Course $N. 65^{\circ}W.$ and ascend.

29.00 Top of Ridge, bears $N. 65^{\circ}W.$ and $S. 65^{\circ}E.$ and descend.

40.00 Set a *Line* stone $15 \times 12 \times 8$ ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on *N.* face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

44.15 Cross Gulch, 7 lks. wide, Course $N. 60^{\circ}W.$ and ascend.

70.00 Top of Ridge, bears $N. W.$ and $S. E.$ and descend.

To allow for convergence, at

79.43 Set a Lava stone $14 \times 12 \times 10$ ins. 9 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 1 and 2 *N.*, R's 62 and 63 *E.*, marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

Land mountainous.
