Descend. 17.84 Cross Gulch, 39 Iks. wide, Course S. W. and ascend. 40.00 Set a Granite stone 15 x 8 x 4 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for 1 Sec. Cor., marked 1 on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable. 71.00 Top of Ridge, bears N.E. and D. W. and descend. Line stone 13 x & x 6 ins. & ins. in. Set a 80.00 the ground for Cor. to Secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 marked with I notch to on A. and I notch on E. edges and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable. Land mountainous. Soil 2 and and 3rd rate Vegetation of Dagebruch and Bunch grass.
