Before proceeding ~~further~~ with the exteriors of this Tp., I made a change of 5 minutes in the latitude arc of my solar compass by subtracting same from the reading previously given, and at noon verified and corrected same by observation on the sun. I also further tested instrument by reversing.

From the Cor. to Tps. 2 & 3 N. Rs. 62 & 63 E., I run,

West. on a true line between sections 1 and 36.

Va. 16° 30' East.

Descend.

17.84 Cross Gulch, 37 lks. wide, Course S. W. and ascend.

40.00 Set a Granite stone 15 x 8 x 4 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

71.00 Top of Ridge, bears N. E. and S. W. and descend.

80.00 Set a Limestone 13 x 8 x 6 ins. 8 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 marked with 5 notch ∞ on N. and 1 notch on E. edges and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
