40.00 Set a *lime* stone $24 \times 9 \times 8$ ins., 18
ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N.
face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits
impracticable.

54.00 Cross Wash, 15 lks. wide, Course N. 10° E. ^{and ascend.}

66.76 Enter Juniper timber, bears N. and S.

78.84 Set a *lime* stone $14 \times 12 \times 8$ ins. 9 ins. in the
ground, for Cor. to Tps. 2 and 3 N., R's 62 and
61 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a
mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
