80.22 Intersect N.B. of Tp. 16 lks E of cor. to secs 3, 4, 33 & 34

Which is a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, firmly set in the ground, marked T. 27 N. S. 34 on N. E., R. 58 E. S. 3 on S. E. T. 26 N. S. 4 on S. W. and S. 33 on N. W. faces, with 3 notch on E and 3 notch on W edges.

and pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. in each sec., 5 1/2 ft. dist., and mound of earth 2 ft. high, 4 1/2 ft. base around post.

from which cor. I run S 7° E

on a true line between sections 3 & 4 with same va.

40.22 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked 1/4 S. on W face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N and S of post 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base, around post.
