Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N and S of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.
