400.06 on a true line between sections 2 + 3, with same va. Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked 1/4 S. on W. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N. and S. of post 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base, around post.
