Which is a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, firmly set in the ground, marked T27N. 33 on N. E., R. 60 E. S. 4 on S. E. T26N S. 4 on S. W. and S. 32 on N. W. faces, with 4 notches on E and 2 notches on W. edges.
