40.00 Set temporary 1/4 sec. cor. on top of low divide bear N10E and descend to
62.00 Ravine about 40 feet deep, course S70W and ascend and enter mountains,

80.12 Intersect N. B. of Tp. 12 1/2 lks W of cor. to secs. 5, 6, 31 & 32 which is a stone 18 x 8 x 6 ins. 12 ins. in the ground marked with 5 notch on E and 1 notch on W edges and mound of stone alongside. whence bears
A Pine 10 ins. diam., S14°E 35 lks. dist. marked T. 26N R. 61E S. 5 B. T.
A Pine 8 ins. diam., S25°W 15 lks. dist. marked T. 26N R. 61E S. 6 B. T.
A Pine 8 ins. diam., N16°W 21 lks. dist. marked T. 27N R. 61E S. 31 B. T.
A Pine 12 ins. diam., N87°E 19 lks. dist. marked T. 27N R. 61E S. 32 B. T.
from which cor. I run S51°W on a true line between sections 5 & 6 with same va.

40.12 Set a post 5 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked 1/4 S. on W face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N and S of post 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base, around post.
