39.82 A Nut Pine 6 ins. diam. which I marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S. on W face for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins.

79.82 The cor. to secs. 3, 4, 9 + 10
