Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N and S of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.

Intersect the *Diablo* Standard Parallel North at a point 19.16 chs. W. of the Standard Cor. to Secs. 34 and 35 T. 31 N. R. 60 E

Which is a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, firmly in the ground, marked T 31 N. R. 60 E O. C. on N.

S 35 on E and S 34 on W. faces, with 2 notches on E and 4 notches on W edges. Pits N.E. and W of post and Mound of Earth around post at point of intersection.

Set a Limestone 18 x 12 x 10 ins. 12 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 2 and 3 marked C. with 2 notches on E. and 4 notches on W. edges, and raised a mound of Earth alongside
