Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., W and S. of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.

Intersect the *South* Standard Parallel North at a point 17.59 chs. W of the Standard Cor. to Secs. 32 and 33 T. 31 N. R. 59 E.

Which is a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, firmly set in the ground, marked T. 31 N. R. 60 E. S. 32 on W S 33 on E and S 32

on W faces, with 4 notches on E and 2 notches on W edges. Pits 70 E $\frac{1}{4}$ W of post and Mound of earth around post at point of intersection S.

Set a Limestone 15 x 12 x 10 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 4 and 5 marked C. with 4 notches on E. and 2 notches on W. edges, and raised a mound of earth alongside

Which is a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, firmly set in the ground, marked T. 31 N. S. 33 on N. E., R. 60 E. S. 4 on S. E. R. 60 E. S. 5 on S. W. and S. 32 on N. W. faces, with 4 notches on E and 2 notches on W edges.

and pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. in each sec., $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and mound of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.
