<i>10.00</i>	Creek <i>6</i> lks. wide, runs <i>S.E.</i> and ascend along <i>S.W.</i> slope of ridge
<i>40.00</i>	Set a <i>Line</i> stone <i>16 x 14 x 8</i> ins. <i>10</i> ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on <i>W</i> face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Whence bears <i>N</i> <i>Lead</i> <i>16</i> ins. diam. <i>N 64° 10' 36</i> lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S. B. T. No other tree within the limits
