



Survey made with Burt's Patent  
Improved Solar compass, nearly  
new, and in first rate order,  
Made by Dr. & S. C. Govey of  
Troy, N. Y., in 1851.  
Before proceeding with the exterior  
of this Sp., I made a change of 15  
minutes in the latitude arc of my  
solar compass, by subtracting same  
from the reading previously given,  
and at noon verified and corrected  
same by observation on the sun.  
I also further tested instrument  
by reversing. Took the  
latitude & found it to be  
 $N. 35^{\circ} 48'$
