Chains,

Before proceeding further with the exteriors of this Tp., I made a change of 6 minutes in the latitude arc of my solar compass by subtracting same from the reading previously given, and at noon verified and corrected same by observation on the sun. I also further tested instrument by reversing.

From the Cor. to Tps. 26 & 27 N. Rs. 63 & 64 E, I run,

North on a true line between sections 31-36 Va. 15° East.

Over rolling land.

140.00 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. 12 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked 1/4 S. on N. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., E. and W. of post 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base around post.

80.00 Set a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Secs, 25-30-31-36 marked T. 26 S., S. 30, on N. E. R. 64 E., S. 31 on S. E., S. 36 on S. W, and S. 25 on N. W, face, with / notch on S, and 5 notches on N, edges, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins, in each Sec., 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, 4 1/2 ft. base around post.
