80.00 Set a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Secs. 25-30-31-36, marked T, 26 S., 31, on N, E, R, 63 E., S. 31 on S, E, S, 36 on S, W, and S, 25 on N, W, face, with \backslash notch on S, and $\bar{\cup}$ notch on E, edges, dug pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. in each Sec., $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.
