Mark on a true line between sections 1-6
 Va. 15° East.

Over rolling land.

40.00 Set a Basalt stone $15 \times 10 \times 7$ ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on N face, dug pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins., S and N. of stone $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base.

80.00 Set a Basalt stone $15 \times 10 \times 6$ ins. 10 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 25 and 26 S. R's 62 and 63 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, dug pits, $24 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. lengthwise on each line, N. S. E. and W. of stone, 6 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, 5 ft. base.
