face and raised a mound of stone.

Pits impracticable.

79.90 Intersect the 44<sup>th</sup> Standard Parallel South at a  
point 16.12 chs. West of the Standard Cor. to  
Tps. 16 S., R's 65-66 E.; at which  
point I.

Set a Boulder stone 17 x 16 x 13 ins. 11 ins. in the  
ground, for Noting Cor. to Tps. 17 S., R's 65 and  
66 E., marked C.C. with 6 notches on S.W. Wedges,  
and raised a mound of stone, Pits impracticable,
