S. B., T. 36 N., R. 20 E., Mt. D. M.

Chains.

East. on a true line on S. B. of Section 36.

Va.  $17^{\circ} 25'$  East.

Over broken land.

Descend.

9.00 Cross low Sag and ascend.

18.50 Top of Spur, bears  $71.30^{\circ}$  W.  $\text{q}_{\text{w}}$   $8.30^{\circ}$  E. and descend.

25.50 Cross low Sag and ascend.

30.75 Top of Spur, bears  $71.35^{\circ}$  W.  $\text{q}_{\text{w}}$   $8.35^{\circ}$  E. and descend.

40.00 Set a Volcanic stone  $17 \times 12 \times 10$  ins., 11 ins. in the ground, for Standard  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked S. C.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

47.50 Enter dry water course, runs  $71.88^{\circ}$  W.

50.75 Leave dry water course, bears  $8.85^{\circ}$  W.

59.25 Cross Gulch, 75 lks. wide, Course  $71.35^{\circ}$  W. and ascend.

80.00 Set a Volcanic stone  $19 \times 12 \times 8$  ins. 14 ins. in the Standard ground, for Cor. to Tps. 36 N., R's 20 and 21 E., marked S. C. with 6 notches on N. E. & W. wedges, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable, Land mountainous.
