

6 7th Standard Parallel along.

S. B., T. 36 N., R. 20 E., Mt. D. M.

Chains.

East. on a true line on S. B. of Section 36,

Va. $17^{\circ} 25'$ East.

Over broken land.

Descend.

9.00 Cross low Sag and ascend.

18.00 Top of Spur, bears N. 30° W. $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 30° E. and descend.

25.00 Cross low Sag and ascend.

30.75 Top of Spur, bears N. 35° W. $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 35° E. and descend.

40.00 Set a Volcanic stone $17 \times 12 \times 10$ ins., 11 ins. in the ground, for Standard $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked S. C. $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

47.00 Enter dry water course, runs N. 88° W.

50.75 Leave dry water course, bears S. 85° W.

59.25 Cross Gulch, 7 fks. wide, Course N. 35° W. and ascend.

80.00 Set a Volcanic stone $19 \times 12 \times 8$ ins. 14 ins. in the ground, for Standard Cor. to Tps. 36 N., R's 20 and 21 E., marked S. C. with 6 notches on N. E. & W. edges, and raised a mound of stone, Pits impracticable, Land mountainous.
