Ascend.

- 1.00 Top of Ridge, bears N. 4^{th} S.
- 3.25 Descend. abruptly.
- 28.00 Descend. gradually.
- 35.00 Cross Ravine, Course S.
- 37.00 Ascend. abruptly.
- 40.00 Set a Volcanic stone $22 \times 20 \times 5$ ins., 16 ins. in the ground, for Standard $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked S. C. $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
- 55.00 Top of Spur, bears N. and S. and descend.
- 66.00 Cross low Sag and ascend.
- 80.00 Set a Volcanic stone $24 \times 10 \times 7$ ins. 18 ins. in the ground, for Standard Cor. to Tps. 36 N., R's 21 and 22 E., marked S. C. with 6 notches on U. E. & W. edges, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
Land mountainous.
- Soil 2nd and 3rd rate
- Vegetation Bunchgrass and Sagebrush.
- I carefully examined the adjustments of my solar compass to-day, particularly the latitude and reversing apparatus, and found them correct.
