Ascend.

40.00 Set a Volcanic stone $20 \times 12 \times 6$ ins., 15 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

48.50 Top of Spur, bears N. 50° W. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. S. 50° E. and descend.

70.50 Top of rocky Bluff, bears E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. W.

80.00 Set a Volcanic stone $20 \times 8 \times 8$ ins. 15 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 33 and 34 N. R's 20 and 21 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
