80.00 Set a Volcanic stone 16 x 8 x 8 ins. 11 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 25-26-35-36 marked with / notch on S. and / notch on E. and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable. from which

A Juniper 5 ins. diam. bears S. 23° W., 47 lks. dist. marked T. 35 N., R. 20 E., S., 35 B. T.

A Juniper 6 ins. diam. bears N. 51° E., 48 lks. dist. marked T. 35 N., R. 20 E., S., 25 B. T.

A Juniper 4 ins. diam. bears N. 29° W., 61 lks. dist. marked T. 35 N., R. 20 E., S., 26 B. T.
