Chains.

*X* North on a true line between sections 1 <sup>and</sup> 6.

Via  $17^{\circ} 58'$  East.

Ascend.

- 23.50 Summit of Fox Peak, 8050 feet above sea level.
- 24.50 Monument of U. S. Topographical Survey bears East about 160 lbs. dist. and descend.
- 240.00 Set a Volcanic stone  $17^{\frac{1}{2}} \times 14^{\frac{1}{2}}$   $\frac{1}{4}$  ins., 11 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
- 58.50 Descend. atmpstly.
- 88.00 Set a Volcanic stone  $18^{\frac{1}{2}} \times 8^{\frac{1}{2}} \times 7$  ins. 12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 36 and 37 N, R's 21 & 22 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
- Land mountainous.
