From the Cor. to Tps. 36 & 37 N. Rs. 19 & 20 E.,  
which is a post in stone mound

I enlarged mound to be 5 ft. at  
base and 3 ft. in height.

I run South on a random line on W. B. of Tp.

Va.  $180^{\circ} 10'$  East.

I set temporary corners at every half mile, and at 6 miles  
72 chs. I arrive at a point 986 lks. East. of <sup>Standard</sup> Cor. to Tps.

36 N., Rs. 19 & 20 E. from which corner I run  
N.  $10^{\circ} 10'$  E. on a true line between sections 31 & 36.

Va.  $170^{\circ} 35'$  East.

Over rolling land.

After diligent search, being unable to find old corner, I

 $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base.

80.00 Set a Volcanic stone  $18 \times 8 \times 7$  ins. 12 ins. in  
the ground for Cor. to Secs. 25, 30, 31 & 36, marked  
with 1 notch on S. and 5 notches on N. edges and  
raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
