I made a change of 6 minutes in the latitude arc
of my solar compass by adding same to
the reading previously given, and at noon verified and
corrected same by observation on the sun. I also fur-
ther tested instrument by reversing.

I took the latitude and found it to be $41^{\circ}06'N$.

From the Cor. to Tps. 37 & 38 N. Rs. 20 & 21 E.,
Which is a volcanic stone in earth mound with pits
I run East on a random line on N. B. of Tp.

Va. $17^{\circ}45'$ East.

I set temporary corners at every half mile, and at 5 miles
79.35 chs. I arrive at a point 147¹/₂ N. of Cor. to Tps,
37-38 N., Rs. 21-22 E.,

From which corner I run.

$N. 89^{\circ}46'N$. on a true line between sections 1-36,

Va. $17^{\circ}55'$ East

6.50 Top of Mt. bears N. 25° W. 98.25 E., and descend.
