North on a true line between sections

1 - 6

Va. $18^{\circ} 20'$ East.

Descend.

40.00 Set a Volcanic stone $18 \times 7 \times 6$ ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, dug pits, $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins., N. and S. of stone $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base.

43.50 Cross Creek, 15 lks. wide, Course ENE and ascend.

49.00 Top of Spur, bears C. and IV, and descend.

70.75 Cross Creek, 25 lks. wide, Course S. 70° E., and ascend.

80.00 Set a Volcanic stone $19 \times 12 \times 6$ ins. 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 38 and 39 N.R.s 21 and 22 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

Land mountainous.
