Survey made with Burt's Patent Improved Solar
Compass, nearly new, and in first rate order. Made
by W. & S. E. Gurley, of Troy,
N. Y. 1881.

This instrument was examined
and compared by me with
the true meridian at Reno, ^{Cal} N. V.
Nevada, on the 22nd day of July
1882 and found to be in
perfect adjustment.

On the 20th day of April, 1883,
I set my instrument at the
Standard Cor. to Tpo. 285, Rs.
65th & 66th, carefully examined
it in all its adjustments
particularly the latitude and
meridian apparatus and
found them correct. I took the
latitude and found it to be
35° 27' N, and proceed to survey
as follows: —
