40.00 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone.  
12 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. on  
W. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N. and S. of  
post 5  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft.  
high, 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base around post.

80.00 Set a basalt stone 24 x 16 x 10 ins. 18 ins. in  
the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 27 and 28. R's 62 and  
63 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, dug pits, 24  
x 18 x 12 ins. lengthwise on each line, N. S. E. and W.  
of stone, 6 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft.  
high, 5 ft. base. alongside.
