37.50 Dry Channel 16 lks. wide, course N 70° W.

40.00 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for 1/2 Sec. Cor., marked 1/2 S. on W face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N and S of post 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base, around post.

79.62 Intersect the *Fifth* Standard Parallel North at a point 26 lks East of the Standard Cor. to Secs. 34 and 35 T. 26 N. 35 E

which is a stone 15 x 12 x 8 ins. 10 ins. in the ground marked with V notches on E and 4 notches on W edges and mound of stone

At point of intersection 2
Set a *granite* stone 12 x 10 x 10 ins. 8 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 2 and 3 marked C. with V notches on E. and 4 notches on W. edges, and raised a mound of stone alongside.Land level and slightly rolling
