Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N and S of post 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base, around post.

Intersect the Fifth Standard Parallel North at a point 2.1 lks East of the Standard Cor. to Secs. 32 and 33 T. 26 N. R. 35 E

which is a stone 14 x 8 x 4 ins. 9 ins. in the ground marked with 4 notches on E and 2 notches on W edges and mound of stone

At point of intersection I

Set a *hand* stone 12 x 12 x 12 ins. 8 ins. in the ground for *County* Cor. to Secs. 4 and 5 marked C. C. with 4 notches on E. and 2 notches on W. edges, and raised a mound of stone alongside.
