40.00 Set a post 5 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on *W* face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., *N* and *S* of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.

79.12 Intersect the *Fifth* Standard Parallel North at a point *18 LK E* of the Standard Cor to Secs. 31 and 32 T. 26 N R. 35 E

which is a stone $12 \times 10 \times 8$ ins. 8 ins. in the ground marked with 5 notches on *E* and 1 notch - on *W* edges and mound of stone

at point of intersection. Set
Set a granite stone $15 \times 12 \times 10$ ins. 10 ins. in the ground for *Closing* Cor. to Secs. 5 and 6 marked *C* with 5 notches on *E*. and 1 notch - on *W*. edges, and raised a mound of stone alongside.
