

EIGHTH STANDARD PARALLEL NORTH

THROUGH RANGE 47 EAST

West on south boundary of section. 0°/

Va 18° East.

Over rolling hills

40.00 Set a post $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 3 ins. diam. 12 ins. in the ground, for Standard $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked S. C. $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 and of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.

58.00 Ravine about 70 feet deep, course N.

80.00 Set a post $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the ground for Standard cor. to Twp 47 N Rgs 46 & 47 marked S. C., T. 47 N on N R 47 N S. 31 on S and R 46 S. 36 on W faces with 6 notches on S and 6 notches on W faces, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. of post, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.
