

## EIGHTH STANDARD PARALLEL NORTH

## THROUGH RANGE 47 EAST

West on south boundary of section. 31/

Va 18° East.

Over rolling hills

- 40.00 Set a post  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long, 3 ins. diam. 12 ins. in the ground, for Standard  $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. Cor., marked S. C.  $\frac{1}{2}$  on N. face, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 and of post  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base around post.

58.00 Ravine about 70 feet deep, course No.

- 80.00 Set a post  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the ground for Standard cor. to T<sub>46</sub> + 47 marked S. C., T. 47 on N. R. 47 N. S. 31 on E and R 46 E S. 36 on W faces with 6 notches on E and 6 notches on W faces, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  W of post,  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high,  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base around post.
