

EIGHTH STANDARD PARALLEL NORTH  
THROUGH RANGE 45 EAST

West on south boundary of section 37 -  
Va. 18° East.

Ascend Over rolling hills  
38.70 Cross Road, bears  $D 77^{\circ} W$  and  $N 022^{\circ} E$ .  
40.00 Set a post  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long, 3 ins. diam. 12 ins. in the  
ground, for Standard  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked S. C.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N.  
face, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12  $E$  and  $W$  of post  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft.  
dist., and raised a mound of earth  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft.  
base around post.

43.00 Top of Divide bears  $N 0^{\circ} E$  and descend  
80.00 Set a *Wackly* stone 10 x 10 x 8 ins. 7 ins. in the  
ground for Standard Cor. to  $T 41^{\circ} N R 9. 44 \& 45$  marked S.  
C. with  $\odot$  notches on E. and  $\odot$  notches on  $W$ . edges,  
dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins.  $N. E.$  and  $W.$   
and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high,  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base
