

EIGHTH STANDARD PARALLEL NORTH
THROUGH RANGE 45 EAST

West on south boundary of section 31

Va. 18° East.

Ascend over rolling hills

38.70 Cross Road, bears, $SW^{\circ}W$ and $Northeast E.$

40.00 Set a post $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 3 ins. diam. 12 ins. in the ground, for Standard $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked S. C. $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, dug pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ D and W of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.

43.00 Top of Divide bears $NE^{\circ}W$ and S and descend

80.00 Set a Macaby stone $10 \times 10 \times 8$ ins. 7 ins. in the ground for Standard Cor. to Tp 41 N Rg 44 $\frac{1}{4}$ S marked S. C. with 6 notches on E. and 6 notches on W. edges, dug pits, $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. $NE^{\circ}E$ and W . and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base.
