

Chains

From the corner to Sections 35, 36, on the South boundary,

which is a stone $28 \times 10 \times 10$ ins. in the ground marked with 5 notches on W. and 1 notch on E. edges and mound of stone. *Iron*

North on a true line between sections $35 \frac{1}{4}$ & 36

Va. $16 \frac{3}{4}^\circ$ East.

Ascend along *SW* slope of ridge

through scattering timber

Set a *Paint* stone $29 \times 23 \times 18$ ins. 22 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on *W* face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

4. *Nut Pine* 11 ins. diam., $N 5 \frac{1}{2}^\circ E$ 15 fms. dist. marked T. 21 N. R. 36 E. S., 25 B. T.
