marked with $\vee$ notch on $\vee$ on $\vee$ and 4 notches on Wedges
and mound of stone I run

North on a true line between sections

Set a *Chumbe* stone 21 x 16 x 11 ins. 16
ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on $\vee$
face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

Bottom of Ravine about 90 ft. deep course $\vee$
and ascend along $\vee$ slope of ridge bears N. 45° E.

Set a *Trap* stone 17 x 17 x 8 ins. 12 ins. in
the ground for Cor. to Secs. 26, 27, 34 3/4 35 marked
with 1 notch — on S. and $\vee$ notches on E. edges and
raised a mound of stone alongside. Whence bears

4 Nut Pine 7 ins. diam., S 28° W 20 fks. dist.
marked T. 21 N R. 36 E S., 34 B. T.
