40.00 Set a Lime stone $16 \times 13 \times 9$ ins. $\frac{1}{11}$ ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on N. face, dug pits, $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins., N. and S. of stone $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, alongside.

82.24 Intersect the 6^{th} Standard Parallel South at a point S. of chs. West of the Standard Cor. to Secs. 31 and 36 Tps. 24S., R's 59 and 60E, marked C. C. with 6 notches on S.E. Wedges, is a limestone in stone & rock mound, set a Lime stone $24 \times 19 \times 10$ ins. $\frac{1}{8}$ ins. in the ground, for Closing Cor. to Tps. 25S., R's 59 and 60E, marked C. C. with 6 notches on S.E. Wedges, and raised a mound of stone, alongside.
