Before proceeding further with the exterior of this Tps., I made a change of 5 minutes in the latitude arc of my solar compass by adding same to the reading previously given, and at noon verified and corrected same by observation on the sun. I also further tested instrument by reversing.

Set a post  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long, 4 ins. square, with marked stone 12 ins. in the ground, for Closing Cor. to Tps. 25 S., R's 56 and 57 E., marked C. C. T: 25 S.; on N, R. 57 E., S. 6, on E. and R. 56 E. S. 1 on W. faces with 6 notches on N. E. & W. faces, dug pits, 24 x 18 x 12 ins, crosswise on each line, N. E. & W. of post, 6 ft. dist, and raised a mound of earth  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, 5 ft. base, around post,
