South on a true line between sections 1 - 6,
Lat. 14° 55' East.

Over rolling land.

33.44 Cross Road, from Bennets to Granpah,
bears N.W. and S.E.

35.63 Intersect Boundary line between Nevada, and
California at a point which bears N. 45° W. 32 lbs.
from the 53⁴ mile post, which is a
post in earth mound & pits,

Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the
ground, for Cor. to Secs. 1 and 6 marked C. G.

T. 25 S., R. 56 57th Con N., S. 6 on N and S. 6 on
E faces, with 1 notch on N and 5 notches
on S faces, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. N.C. & W. of post,
5½ ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, 4½
ft. base around post.
