impracticable.

74.93 Intersect the 6th Standard Parallel Sub at a
point 4.32 chs. West of the Standard Cor. to
Secs. 33 and 34 T. 24S., R. 5E. at which
point 1 is a Limestone in stone m. &c.

Set a Lime stone $19 \times 17 \times 12$ ins. 14 ins. in
the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 3 and 4
marked C. C. with 3 notches on E. and 3 notches on
W. edges and raised a mound of stone. alongside.
Pits impracticable.
